- Update select educational furniture and equipment

- Renovate design center and art rooms to provide modern, flexible space for design, art and vocal music
- Upgrade auditorium sound and video systems
- Improve opportunity for student collaboration and exploration
- Improve accessibility per American Disabilities Act

CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADES

- Provide air conditioning for summer program and community use
- Heating, ventilation, ductwork, controls and piping
- Replace obsolete electrical system components
- Replace lighting to improve learning environment and energy efficiency
- Remodel select restrooms and replace obsolete and worn plumbing fixtures and piping
- Replace select doors, windows, roofing, railings and exterior steps
- Correct site drainage where needed
