Students may also earn their third Science credit through a personal curriculum by participating in designated Oakland Schools Technical Campus (OSTC) programs during their junior and/or senior year.

Students should always consult with their counselor and admissions websites when selecting courses so that they align with their future college plans and intended fields of study. Additionally, students may choose to take more than one science course starting in their 11th grade year.
