Greetings BHS Families,

While our **<u>state-mandated</u>** standardized testing is not until April, I wanted to send out a quick note detailing the specific tests, the daily schedule for each grade, and other important testing information. One very important item to note is that the College Board has transitioned the SAT suite of assessments (<u>PSAT 9</u>, <u>PSAT 10</u>, <u>SAT</u>) to a *digital* test format.

**For digital testing, all students must bring in their district Chromebook**. There are a limited number of Chromebooks available only to students who have never had a district Chromebook assigned to them.

REQUIRED DIGITAL READINESS CHECK   for 9th + 10th + 11th Graders w/ district Chromebook			
When is the DRC?	To prepare for the digital PSAT/SAT all 9th, 10th, 11th graders <i>must</i> participate in the <i>Digital Readiness Check (DRC)</i> <b>during English class on April 2nd.</b> ** Any 11th graders who attend CASA for English must report to College + Career Center during hours 1-4.)		
What is the DRC?	<b>Students will log-into the Bluebook app and access a test preview where they will be able to:</b> 1) Get familiar with functions in the app, 2) See the structure of the test, 3) Try a small sample of Reading and Writing and Math questions to become familiar with the kinds of questions they'll encounter on test day and with how to properly enter their answers.		

Required Tech for DRC	The DRC must be done on a Berkley School District Chromebook. You must bring in the district Chromebook assigned to you on April 2nd (and on test days)! There are a limited number of Chromebooks available if you do not have a district Chromebook.		
Opt-in Features	During the <i>DRC</i> , students will be asked if they would like to opt-in to the College Board's <u>BigFuture School mobile app</u> and <u>Connections</u> . We will be advising students to decline, informing them that they can choose to download the app from home, with parent/guardian permission.		
Test Prep Resources	<ul> <li>Students are able to download the <u>Bluebook app</u> on their personal computer or Chromebook for practice tests and familiarizing themselves with the digital testing format. <u>Click here</u> for more information on practice.</li> <li>Students are still able to use <u>Khan Academy</u> as a free, comprehensive test preparation tool. Khan Academy's digital SAT course content includes videos, articles, and worked examples designed to help you understand and experience what's new about the digital SAT Suite.</li> </ul>		
11th Graders: Option to Send SAT Scores to Colleges	<ul> <li>11th graders will be given an option to send their SAT scores for free to up to four colleges.</li> <li>This is optional. Colleges do not have automatic access to test scores. Students must elect to send their SAT scores to colleges.</li> <li>Many colleges are continuing with test-optional policy - meaning SAT scores are not required for admission. If your student is interested in a particular college, they should visit the college's admission website or contact the college admissions representative for information on admission requirements/testing policies.</li> </ul>
